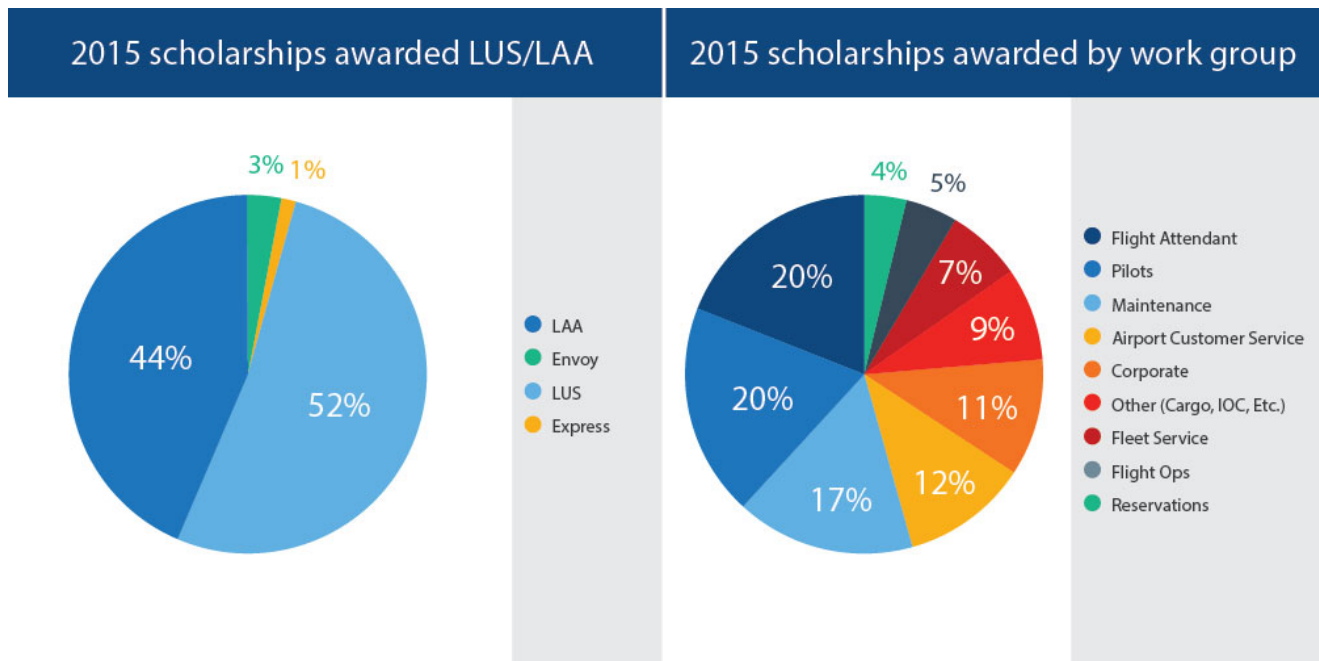
Makenna Sowards, daughter of PHX-based Reservations Agent [Elizabeth Sowards](#) was a 2015 award winner.
